On an ongoing basis since 1994, Clifford has successfully been awarded numerous phases of the building envelope stabilization, including the salvage and rebuild of existing façade and structures, repair and replacement of existing sandstone and roman stone units, restoration of existing steel windows and conservatory skylight, and more.

THE DON JAIL

TORONTO

For Clifford, the Bridgepoint Hospital project was composed of two parts. The bulk of the project consisted of restoration to the existing building – the former Don Jail. A portion of this work included masonry cleaning. Dutchman and Jahn repairs, salvage and resetting of the interior stone floor, and installation of the new ventilator towers. In addition, Clifford also surveyed, documented, relocated and conserved the 85-foot long glass tile mosaic wall mural entitled 'Life' by Kitchener artist, Margit Gatterbauer.

HAMILTON

Clifford Restoration Limited was contracted to perform treatments, as required, upon defining a comprehensive scope of work to restore this culturally significant building in Hamilton. Work performed to the interior and exterior included masonry restoration, glazed architectural terra cotta repairs and replacement, window restoration, and installation of flashings to protect the façade from further deterioration. The exterior

store fronts were repaired, in addition to the interior glazing and wood store fronts, which were reconstructed from the use of archival photos.


















ST. MICHAEL'S CATHEDRAL

TORONTO

Over the course of numerous phases of restoration to the iconic Toronto Cathedral, the work performed at St Michael's included restoration to the basement crypts; exterior facade restoration; supply and install of new stone pinnacles, finials, cornice, and niches; narthex and liturgical finishes; new holy water fonts; and fenestration restoration.

TORONTO

The former National Building façade, originally constructed in 1926, is incorporated into a 51-storey office property. To restore the historical 12-storey Tyndall limestone façade, Clifford catalogued, dismantled, and removed the stone from site. Additional work involved full restoration of the steel windows with modifications to achieve a blast proof rating, complete replacement of shelf angles, and rebuild of Tyndall limestone at the West and North façade.



During the restoration of this building, masonry surfaces and the decorative aluminum spandrels were cleaned to showcase its detail, select windows and skylights were restored, and the telechron clock was repaired after years of not being operational. Replacement material was sourced for the wood and stucco jambs based on archival photos, which revealed the original material to be Red Marble.

When the Munk School of Global Affairs expanded to 315 Bloor Street West, the former Dominion Meteorological Building was fully restored and renovated. Included in the conservation scope of work were masonry alterations, exterior façade restoration and cleaning, boundary fence restoration, and main entrance bronze lettering.





















All of the floors throughout the Cathedral were installed by Clifford Masonry. At the perimeter of the Liturgical Furnishings, there is a detailed Celtic knot pattern installed using multi slate tile colours. The pattern also highlights a newly designed Baptismal Fountain – also supplied and installed by the Clifford Group of Companies.


